### **COVID Outbreak at Tillsonburg District Memorial Hospital Declared Over**

The COVID-19 outbreak at Tillsonburg District Memorial Hospital (TDMH) has been declared over. As a result of the outbreak, the hospital had closed to admissions on 2South and 2North in-patient units with patients requiring admission being redirected to Alexandra Hospital, Ingersoll and Woodstock Hospital.

Prior to the outbreak, significant measures were already in place at TDMH to reduce likelihood of transmission of the virus within the facility. Expanded precautions and surveillance were implemented for the duration of the outbreak. “Diligent infection prevention and control measures were key in helping control this outbreak. We are so grateful for the support of all staff, physicians, leaders, Southwestern Public Health as well as Alexandra Hospital, Ingersoll and Woodstock Hospital,” said Mike Bastow, Interim President and CEO.

The hospital first declared an outbreak on January 19, 2022. The hospital’s in-patient units are now open to new admissions.
